

Modi heaps praise on Manmohan as his RS term comes to an end

New Delhi: Amid lack of clarity whether former PM Manmohan Singh will get another term as Rajya Sabha MP, the upper House on Thursday bade a warm farewell to him and 67 other retiring members, with PM Narendra Modi praising his predecessor for his commitment as a parliamentarian.

Modi praised Singh for his 'invaluable thoughts' and recalled that the economist-turned-politician had recently turned up for a Rajya Sabha vote in a wheelchair despite knowing well that the treasury had an unassailable lead.

On another occasion, he came in a wheelchair to vote in an election to choose members of a committee.

Modi's compliments came amid uncertainty whether Singh, a six-time RS member, would get another term. Into his 90s, he has not been keeping good health and had to apply for long leave from Parliament last year.

Modi said the retiring members, irrespective of their party affiliation, should be treated by current and future lawmakers as "guiding lights" given the conduct and brilliance they had displayed over a long period. He said while some MPs were set to return in possibly a sharper and smarter avatar, others would venture beyond the limits of Rajya Sabha to be in the larger public arena, the "Jan Sabha". ment last year. Congress's dwindling strength and the demands from other aspirants can be another constraint, sources said.

The PM's warm words contrasted with his stinging criticism of the Singh-led UPA in RS only a day ago. Participating in the debate on the motion of thanks to the President's address, he had attacked the Singh gov't for "mismanaging" the economy and other "failures".

Singh, however, did not keep Modi from taking a satirical dig at leader of opposition Mallikarjun Kharge for criticising the gov't at a time "when the country has achieved new peaks of success and progress in the past 10 years". Liking the criticism to a "kaala tika" — a customary black spot put on a loved one when she achieves something or dresses well, to ward off the 'evil eye' — the PM thanked Kharge for ensuring that nobody could cast an evil eye on India's journey towards progress. He even took a dig at opposition MPs for having staged a "fashion parade" by turning up in black clothes in the last session to protest against the suspension of fellow members.

"I was thinking all will turn up in black clothes but the black magic has rubbed off to create a 'black paper'," he said, referring to the compilation of Congress's charges against the gov't.

Cong releases 'black paper' on failures of Modi gov't

Party Flags Unemployment, Neglect Of Non-BJP States

New Delhi: The Congress on Thursday released a "black paper" to highlight the "failures" of the Modi government and alleged that the last 10 years have been a period of "injustice" and of "discrimination" against states headed by non-BJP dispensations.

The 'black paper', titled '10 saal anyay kaal' also alleged that issues such as rising prices, unemployment, subversion of institutions and farmers' "distress" had plagued the country.

Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge released the 54-page "charge sheet" against the Centre ahead of the government's tabling in Parliament of a 'white paper' on the "mismanagement" of the economy prior to 2014 aimed at drawing lessons.

"Whenever PM (Narendra) Modi presents his views in Parliament, he hides his failures. At the same time, when we speak about the failures of the government, it is not given importance. Therefore, we thought of bringing out a black paper and tell the public about the failures of the government," Kharge, who was flanked by party leaders Pawan Khera and Syed Nasser Hussain, said at a press conference at his residence here.

With the hashtag '10 saal anyay kaal', Rahul Gandhi said in a post in Hindi on X, "Filled friend's coffers with

country's wealth and the youth only got the 'disease of unemployment.' In a sharp attack at Prime Minister Modi over his claim that the Congress was creating a narrative to divide the country into north and south, Kharge said those who falsely accuse others of dividing the country and of regionalism, "those liars" do not even remember what they said.

"Modi ji, when you were the chief minister of Gujarat, you used to talk about the tax rights of Gujarat with the UPA government. Then you said that states should get 50 per cent tax. You also said that people of Gujarat pay Rs 48,600 crore tax and get only 2.5 per cent back," Kharge said.

Kharge also alleged that during Modi's chief ministership, he incited violence and

said such a person should not talk about south and north divide. In the presser, Kharge also alleged that there is a "danger to democracy" in the country and accused the BJP of attempting and also toppling elected governments.

"Non-BJP ruled states such as Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Kerala and Andhra Pradesh are being discriminated against and neglected. They (Centre) don't release funds and then say we have released the funds but it was not spent. They purposely stall work... this is a big conspiracy of the BJP," he alleged.

Kharge also alleged that the Modi government was "extorting" money through the route of electoral bonds.

"They are using this money to finish democracy. They

made 411 MLAs cross over to their side. We had elected governments in Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Goa, Manipur and Uttarakhand. You know how governments were made to fall," he said.

Kharge also claimed that he got abusive calls a few days ago and he has got a case registered in a police station.

"When I was small, we lost so much. Only I was left along with my father in my family... But they target me, defame me, abuse me. A person who is a Scheduled Caste has no one behind him. They want to defame such a person," he said.

Hitting out at the BJP, Kharge said they make a big deal about the president belonging to the Scheduled Caste community or Scheduled Tribe community. "We also made internationally known and well-educated Scheduled Caste person the president. I am not criticising the present president," he said. The "black paper" highlights social, economic and political "injustices" committed during the Modi government's tenure. "The Modi government's 10 years in power have devastated the country's economy, aggravated unemployment, destroyed the country's agricultural sector, abetted crimes against women and committed grave injustices against minorities in the country," the party alleged in its document.

Cong brought 'black paper' to hide its black deeds, says BJP

New Delhi: Hitting back at Congress over its 'black paper' against the Modi gov't, BJP on Thursday claimed that the opposition party had brought it to hide its "black deeds" and was in pain as it wanted action in corruption cases stopped.

"But this will not happen. PM Modi has made it clear that there will be no compromise on the issue of corruption. There is no place for those who have looted (public money). We will expose your black deeds to people," BJP leader Ravi Shankar Prasad said after Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge released a "black paper" to highlight the central gov't's alleged failures. "Those who indulged in corruption and were behind

scams worth lakhs of crores of rupees are bringing out black paper," Prasad said and asserted that the "story of scams" was over and the country was progressing under Modi's leadership. He added that the gov't had weeded out accounts of over 10 crore fictitious beneficiaries of gov't schemes.

Prasad said India was seen as a fragile economy and was identified with "policy paralysis" when the Congress-led UPA was in office, while it was now the fifth largest global economy and its forex reserves and foreign investment were on the rise. He dismissed Congress's claim of a rise in price of essential items and unemployment, and cited figures to assert that the Modi gov't had created a lot of employment and tackled inflation much better than the UPA. "We will expose Congress. People are going to give no importance to it," he added.

Bills to amend SC, ST lists in Andhra, Odisha passed in Parl

New Delhi: Parliament gave its nod to two bills which seek to modify the list of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in Andhra Pradesh and Odisha, with Lok Sabha on Thursday passing them with voice vote, and the opposition also supporting them.

The Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order (Amendment) Bill, 2024, and the Constitution (Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) Order (Amendment) Bill, 2024 were both passed by Rajya Sabha on Tuesday.

The first bill seeks to modify the list of Scheduled Tribes in Andhra Pradesh while the second one seeks to modify the list of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in Odisha.

Replying to the debate on the bills, junior minister for tribal affairs Bharti Pawar said the Narendra Modi government has done a lot for the upliftment of tribal people, including efforts to make aspirational districts to inspirational ones. More over, the gov't has launched schemes such as Pradhan Mantri Janati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan to improve the socio-economic conditions of primitive vulnerable tribal groups (PVTGs), she said.

In Andhra Pradesh, three more ethnic groups — Bondo Porja, Khond Porja and Parangiperja — are being added to the list of STs. In Odisha, it will add four groups in the list. All these are PVTGs and have been added to the scheduled list after 75 years of Independence, she added.

During the debate, opposition members urged gov't to form a joint parliamentary committee to evaluate demands of various communities to be included in the list of STs, saying piecemeal measures don't help.

Initiating the debate, Congress member from Odisha Saptagiri Sankar Ulaka welcomed the bill but pointed out that about 150 to 200 tribes have been added to the list of Scheduled Tribes in the past five years.

"There are around 12 crore Scheduled Tribes

across the country. When we were in gov't, there used to be a procedure, where a JPC was constituted. MPs were part of it. They used to visit places, check the criteria and recommend who is ST and who is not," Ulaka said.

"In the last four-five years, I think we have included almost 150 to 200 tribes in Scheduled Tribes. In Odisha, anyone who comes demanding ST status, the state gov't sends it to the Centre. They have sent around 180 tribes to be considered as ST. This naturally raises a concern if the demands are genuine or not," he said, and added a JPC should look into the issue.

NCP MP (Sharad Pawar faction) Supriya Sule and Abdul Khaleque of the Congress also demanded that the Centre should form a JPC for meeting various communities that demand ST status and a comprehensive bill can be brought before Parliament. TMC's Saugata Roy, meanwhile, called for simplifying the process for communities to get ST status.

Cong MP demands white paper on Manipur

New Delhi: Congress member K Suresh on Thursday asked gov't to come out a "white paper" on the ethnic violence in Manipur and said Christian missionaries and priests are facing threat with churches being vandalised in several states.

Raising the issue during zero hour in Lok Sabha, Suresh alleged that repeated vandalisation of churches in Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan; and continued assault on Christian missionaries and priests "by right-wing group is alarming". He alleged that by refusing to take action against the goons, BJP is supporting those who are indulging in violence.

"The arrest of Father Anil Mathew who was wrongly implicated and jailed shows hatred against Christian missionaries and priests by the Madhya Pradesh government. I request the Madhya Pradesh gov't to seek a report in this matter and the human rights commission to take up the matter suo motu," Suresh said. He demanded that the central government place a "white paper" on the Manipur situation and ethnic violence in House.
